Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR) presentation	Angel Garcia, OYCR

Angel Garcia from the Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR) provided a general overview about what OYCR does. Their mission is to promote trauma responsive, culturally informed services for the youth involved in the juvenile justice system. OYCR has six key points: youth centered, community, equity focus, compassion, innovate, and data driven. The OYCR mandate is to use data from multiple sources to support efforts across counties to improve youth outcomes. The ombudsperson is responsible for investigating complaints, deciding whether to investigate or refer complaints, publishing regular reports, and informing youth and families of the rights of the youth. The ombudsperson can meet privately with the youth, visit the facilities, and request records. OYCR is engaging with the community, they have completed 36 SYTFs visits, attending the JJC and JJDPC meetings, and meeting with community partners. The BSCC will be moved to the OYCR no later than January 1, 2025. Angel informed everyone that DJJ will be closed as of June 30, 2023, and the youth will be released to YDF by July 1, 2023.
