- **JJCC Subcommittee Member:**
 - The subcommittee shall be composed of the Chief Probation Officer, as chair, and one representative from the District Attorney's Office, the Public Defender's Office, the Department of Social Services, the Department of Mental Health, the County Office of Education or a school district, and a representative from the court.
 - The subcommittee shall select three or more community members or advocates with experience in providing youth services and or with direct involvement in the juvenile justice system.
 - The subcommittee is tasked with developing a DJJ Realignment Plan describing the facilities, programs, placements, services, supervision and reentry strategies that are needed to provide appropriate rehabilitation and supervision services for the population described in subdivision (b) of Section 1990 for submission to the new state Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR).
 - There is no term limit for member positions.
