Title: Access To Healthcare

Functional Area: Governance and Administration

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Policy:

Youths have the right to access health care, are given a professional clinical judgment and receive care that is ordered. Health care is provided to meet the serious medical needs of minors. Youths have the right to access care in a timely manner, be given a professional clinical judgment, and receive care that is ordered. The responsible health authority identifies and eliminates any barriers to youths receiving health care.

Procedures:

- A. Access to Care
 - 1. Youths are to be advised of health care services upon admission into the facility.
 - 2. Youths must be provided an orientation to health care services and procedures in a language and vocabulary that is understandable and age appropriate.
 - 3. Youths requesting to register a grievance about health care services must be referred to probation staff.
 - 4. Youths must be seen in a timely manner with unimpeded access to care.
 - 5. Notify the health administrator for any of the following unreasonable barriers to health care services:
 - a. Punishing youths for seeking care
 - b. Establishing disincentives to deter youths from seeking care for serious health care needs such as sick call held during unreasonable hours.
 - Permitting unreasonable delays before youth is seen by prescribing providers, outside consultants for necessary diagnostic work or treatment for serious health needs.
 - d. Interfering with youths' verbal or written request for healthcare.
 - e. Preventing youth's access to care due to conflicts with school or work programs.
