Policy:

Collection of Statistics of various Medical Clinic Services is paramount to providing and improving clinic services. Daily and monthly stats are collected and then reviewed by Quality Improvement Committee (QIC) to identify areas of excellence and areas where improvement are needed. Statistics are also collected and reported to the Youth Detention Facility (YDF) Probation Administration and California Board of Corrections.

Procedures:

- A. Health information entered in the Electronic Medical Record (EMR) by Juvenile Correctional Health Services–Juvenile staff will be utilized for gathering statistics for Quality Assurance.
 - 1. The EMR collects stats on clinic services provided. These include but are not limited to:
 - a. MD Sick Call Appointments
 - b. MD Chart Reviews
 - c. Physicals
 - d. Psych MD Sick Call
 - e. ER Visits
 - f. Hospital Admissions
 - g. RN Sick Call Appointments
 - h. Positive PPD's
 - i. Full Intakes
 - j. Pre-Intakes
 - k. Pill Call
 - I. Dressing Changes
 - m. Walk-in patient seen
 - n. Pregnant residents
 - o. Treatments
 - p. Clearances, UOF Use of Force

- B. A Senior Office Assistant collects, tabulates and submits stats daily to the Clinic Manager for review.
- C. Stats are generated monthy in a statistics spreadsheet and will be presented to the facility and health administrator for continuous quality improvement.
