## **Purpose and Scope**

- A. Youth Assistance:
  - 1. Youth will receive assistance with needs or concerns that may arise.
  - 2. Youth will receive assistance in requesting contact with their parents, other supportive adults, attorney, clergy, probation officer or other public official.
  - 3. Youth will be provided access to available resources to meet the youth's needs.
  - 4. Youth shall have access to medical, mental health, attorney, clergy or probation officer visitation requests. Youth may also utilize a Your Voice to express concerns, request assistance or request support from a Youth
