OPERATIONS ORDER

CLOTHING-TITLE XV 1480 AND 1482

Purpose and Scope

Each youth will receive clothing that is clean, reasonably fitted, in good repair, and free of holes and tears. Unless work, climate conditions or illness requires more frequent exchanges, outer garments, except footwear, will be exchanged at least one time each week.

Each youth will receive new non-disposable underwear which shall remain with the youth throughout their stay. Clean tee shirts, bras, underwear, and socks shall be exchanged daily; youth shall receive their own underwear back at exchange. Undergarments that are freshly laundered shall be free of stains, including tee shirts and bras.

Suitable clothing is issued to pregnant youth.

Youth Detention Facility staff launders all clothing; shoes are sanitized between juvenile exchanges.

A. Laundry personnel will provide a weekly order form to each unit and inventory all clothing and bedding stored on each unit on the specified days listed below.

MondayUnits 5, 10 and 12TuesdayUnits 14 and 16WednesdayUnits 1, 2 and 8SundayUnits 3, 15 and 17

B. Include completed weekly order form with unit's dirty laundry cart and place cart in unit sally port or by unit door for laundry staff to collect. Ordered items will be placed in the unit's clean laundry cart the following day.
